Dressage

Our regular Dressage clinics give you the opportunity to work on your test riding using all the competition markers and boards in a friendly and supportive environment. The Introduction to Dressage workshop is aimed at those who have never competed at dressage before and want to 'give it a go' It consists of a 45 minute classroom based session, followed by a 1hr riding session in groups of 3 or 4. The workshop is available at 2 levels, Intro (walk and trot only) and Prelim (walk, trot and canter)

Showing

The Showing workshop is geared towards how to ride in a showing class, including working on your individual show and tips on ringcraft. There is also an optional session on turnout for the show ring, including tuition on plaiting.

BHS Stage 1

This year we are holding a 10 week course to prepare you for the British Horse Society Stage 1 exam in Horse Knowledge and Care. This course is ideal for those wanting to take the exam as a stepping stone into a career with horses or if you just want to improve your knowledge. Each session will consist of approx 1hr of theory and 1hr practical. Jumping

Our regular Jumping clinics involve working in a small, friendly group of riders at a similar level to yourself. The group usually works towards jumping a course of fences suitable to the standard of the horses and riders. The Introduction to Jumping workshop is aimed at those who have done no or very little jumping and want to 'give it a go'. It consists of a 1hr riding session in groups of 3 or 4, followed by a 45 minute classroom session looking at the theory of successful jumping.



All our training is with Tracy Bye. Tracy has a degree in Equine Science and Management as well as BHS and ABRS qualifications. She has competed at affiliated dressage, show jumping and eventing.

Private Lessons are also available.
